Thank you for the invitation to your community event next Friday. I will certainly be in attendance and look forward to hearing more about the issues.

Regarding the questionnaire, I did not find it helpful. As to the first question I would have appreciated provided information attached to the questionnaire that would allow someone to intelligently answer whether he/she is opposed to the project or in the alternative, direct them to the TN Dept of Environment site for them to review the documents themselves.

I also found question two terribly muddled and of no real use to anyone. I have to believe it was drawn up as an understandably fearful reaction to the proposed project rather than as an attempt to get useful information. The other questions relate to our citizens and their representatives needing to have information about proposed developments as soon as they can so that they can intelligently be allowed to participate in the decision making process. Which of course is true. I think it would have been better to have explained WADC's failure to do that and ask how the person completing the form feels about WADC's failure to do so. I hope any future questionnaire is better thought out.

Having said that, I, as a layman, have reviewed WADC's Amended Permit Petition (2/17/22). I have also closely read FLC's detailed 12-page Objection to the Petition from its attorney with Butler Snow (3/17/22) and WADC's attorney's response to FLC's Objection (4/7/22). I found the Butler Snow 12-page Objection very compelling.

There is still much work to be done. As a potential member of the court from the 6th district, I believe the court has a vital role to play in this process, as already exhibited by the Nash/Barrett Resolution. The county court has the responsibility to oversee the safe and sensible development of the county, including its infrastructure or use of other counties infrastructures. I look forward to taking on that work.
